March Mission Month. Week 3. The Charge.

"For I have come down from heaven not to do my will but to do the will of him who sent me" (John 6:38). "For the Son of Man came to seek and to save the lost" (Luke 19:10)." Jesus said he had come to do the will of the Father and identified himself as one who came to seek and to save the lost. So much of mission ministry fulfills this effort. One testimony that rises from Africa is that of Peter Koyea, a minister and leader in West Africa. Peter was the pastor of a "church on the road" in Liberia when he received the charge to go to the nation of Guinea to preach the Gospel and plant a church. He left his growing and evangelistic pastorate to begin the work in Guinea. The first few years were very difficult in the predominantly non-Christian nation. He was persecuted, became the focus of voodoo activity, and his family was tragically victimized. However, he persistently prevailed for the charge he received from the Lord and today leads progressive ministry efforts in Guinea Conakry, Guinea Bissau, Cape Verde, and Senegal. The mark of a true missionary is one who despite the persecution, danger, and struggles already faced, will still obey God and accept new opportunities to preach and teach the gospel of Jesus Christ so that the lost can be saved. When we accept the challenge of missions' ministries, our God might take us out of our comfort zone and place us in unfamiliar territory. However, He is forever faithful to complete the good work of His will in our lives. As we continue to seek His will, please sustain our mission leaders throughout the world with prayer and support as the Lord leads.
